

Gieger said he was very surprised to learn that he was the first student from West Essex High School to ever be selected to play in the All-Eastern Honors Concert Band.

"It's a cool opportunity to be a part of a band with the most talented musicians from high schools across the east coast," Gieger said.

Gieger, who has played the tuba since the seventh grade at West Essex Middle School, is a member of the West Essex Marching Band and High School Band, Jazz Band and Brass

Ensemble. Gieger said he plans to major in music or double major in music and something else next year when he goes to college.

Gieger can also play the trombone and piano, but the tuba is his favorite. "The tuba is one of the most important instruments because it sets a foundation for the other instruments," he said.
